OUR MEMBER BLUE RIBBON WINNERS!

Every month our members are encouraged to bring in their latest growing achievements for judging & possible ribbon awards! Make sure you fill out an exhibit form for your plant. It must be completed in full & *printed* so it can be read easily. All information must be completed in full for judging consideration! Make sure:

- 1. Print the full name of the orchid & your full name
- 2. The orchid must be entered in the correct category
- 3. You must have owned the orchid 6 months
- 4. Display your orchid in an attractive container
- 5. **Make sure your orchid is free of pests & disease**

Note on Culture Awards: This award is a reflection on the outstanding cultural practices of the grower! An eligible plant is one that stands out as grown to its fullest potential, in robust health, displaying an unusually high number of blooms. Cultural merit is not necessarily related to size; it is related to quality. This award is not necessarily given out each month.



DID YOU KNOW ORCHID STAMP COLLECTING HAS BECOME A GROWING HOBBY AROUND THE WORLD??

Orchid stamp collecting is an interesting adjunct to the hobby of orchid growing. Orchid stamps take up far less space than a collection of plants, and can withstand months, even years, of benign neglect. Collecting stamps is something that can be pursued no matter where you are in the world. Every country sells stamps. If you're traveling abroad, check the local post office for recent issues. Most cities have several stores catering to stamp collectors and you can combine a visit to different shops with trips to orchid shows. For instance, there is a stamp shop in Richardson, Texas, within walking distance of the building where Dallas holds its annual show. Ask your friends to save any orchid stamps they may receive on their mail. All you need to collect orchid stamps is a keen interest, a stamp album, tongs (round or flat tip, rather than pointy tweezers), and perhaps some glassine envelopes (also useful for storing orchid pollen!).

One can also specialize, within the topic of orchid stamps, into specific genera, countries, or other themes, such as stamps represented endemic national flora, or those issued for World Orchid Conferences.

DID YOU KNOW ORCHID STAMP COLLECTING HAS BECOME A GROWING HOBBY AROUND THE WORLD? (continued)

With international interest in orchids growing over the last 40-50 years, people have started collecting stamps depicting orchids and more countries have started issuing such stamps to keep up with the demand. This has become quite a popular stamp group as you can see from Topical Stamps an online vendor. Orchids are one of the many items included in what is called Topical Stamp Collecting. –or collecting of stamps which have a specific theme.

Some people collect stamps from specific countries and others specific species or genera such as Cattleya or Laelia.

According to some sources, the first orchid stamp was issued by Guadeloupe, a Caribbean island, in 1905. It has vanilla beans and the vanilla orchid vine. Since then many other countries have issued them. The United States and Canada have issued several series of stamps, mostly of native orchid species. The tropical countries have issued stamps in all kinds of configurations – species, genera and mixed species. Australia has recently been active in issuing stamps of its native orchids. Here is part of an orchid stamp collection shared with us by a collector named Karl in Ft Lauderdale.


Training begins at 12:30 PM Nominations begin at 2:00 PM Judging begins at 2:30 PM




